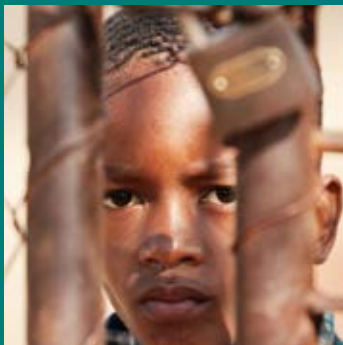
Psychological First Aid is a humane, supportive response to a child who is suffering and who may need support. It is an essential tool for any humanitarian worker who deals with distressed children and families.
