
The READY Learning Hub provides a variety of courses, digital simulations, and resources for humanitarian actors to strengthen their readiness and response to major disease outbreaks.




60+ courses on outbreaks


Is this your first time on Kaya?

- 3. Submit the form. An email will be sent to the email address provided
- 4. Click the link in the email to confirm your registration
- Your account will be confirmed and you will be able to log in and access the READY Learning Hub

Is this your first time here? To take part in courses on Kaya you will need to create a free account. Do this by following the steps below. Why do I need an account? We need to know which courses you take so that we can keep a record of your progress, award you your certificates, and suggest other courses you might be interested in. We also need to know who is taking part in courses so that we can look at the impact of the courses we offer and make sure we are creating courses that you want to join. Finally, many of our courses are created using donations. We need to be able to report to our donors on the numbers of people who are using the content we create. We will not pass your personal information to our donors. How do I create an account? 1. Complete the registration form at kayaconnectorg/register 2. When you submit the form, an email will be sent to the email address you have given us 3. To confirm your registration, click the link in the email 4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be able to log in and start taking courses
