







CPiE Entry-level Online is an open-access self-directed course designed for child protection practitioners who want to strengthen their understanding of child protection in humanitarian response in both chronic crises and new emergencies.

The course may also serve as a useful resource for those working in other areas but wanting to improve their understanding of child protection in emergencies through this entry-level content.

The course was developed in collaboration with Save the Children and the **Alliance for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action** Learning and Development Working Group, and explicitly incorporates the Alliance for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action's Minimum Standards e-learning modules.

The course can also be used as a stand-alone learning resource, as foundational learning for the blended CPiE Fundamentals course and, in future, for the planned Intermediate and Advanced CPiE PDP courses.

The CPiE Entry-level Online course takes about 25 hours to complete and digital badges can be earned by completing the learning content and assessment activity at the end.



The course is currently available in **English** and **Arabic**, with other language versions planned.
