







A sector-facing Arabic course for education/education in emergencies (EiE) practitioners based in GAZIANTEP

Facilitated in-person training: 24 July 28 July 2023 (Modules 1-6)

Education is a fundamental component of a humanitarian response: it contributes to the physical and psychological protection of children, their families, and communities; it supports and promotes the continuation of child development and learning and helps prevent drop out; it presents an opportunity to improve the reach, quality and relevance of education, including building resilience. A key part of being able to initiate, design and implement timely and quality education in emergencies (EiE) responses is having the education/EiE staff with the right competencies to do so.

Developing these competencies where they are needed - in emergency-prone contexts, countries and regions - is the aim of the inter-agency EiE Professional Development Programme (PDP), which includes the EiE Fundamentals.

As the name suggests, the EiE Fundamentals course aims to equip country office education and EiE staff with the fundamental competencies to be part of initiating, designing or adapting and implementing an EiE response in their context.



In line with the EiE PDP curriculum, EiE Fundamentals comprises six modules:

- 1. Foundational Concepts and Frameworks of EiE
- 2. Cross-cutting Issues and approaches in EiE
- 3. Assessment, Analysis and Design in EiE
- 4. Physical and Psychological Protection and Wellbeing in EiE
- 5. Teaching, Learning and Improving Outcomes in EiE
- 6. Enabling and Supporting EiE

In Gaziantep, the course will be delivered in Arabic to a cohort of 25-30 learners through a Facilitated in-person training:

24 July – 28 July 2023 (Modules 1-6)

This Facilitated in-person training course is delivered by the Regional EiE PDP team with the support of technical facilitators from the Education in Emergencies team from Save the Children and the Education Cluster. Learners are expected to attend all facilitated sessions and actively engage in the activities and tasks, and to complete the additional pre-work before each session (as well as the baseline, endline tests and module feedback).

Applications are open to all practitioners working EiE or education in emergency-prone parts of Gaziantep, working for local and national organisations, government, international NGOs, or UN agencies. Access for local and national organisations and government is prioritised and supported. There are no fees for this course and additional support for priority applicants is available on request.
