The Humanitarian Leadership Academy, Save the Children, Centre for Humanitarian Impact CHI, and Sphere are working together to deliver an **Introductory training on Sphere Standards** - to strengthen the quality and accountability of humanitarian response in Gaza. The programme will include several cohorts, followed by a Training of Trainers (ToT) to build sustainable local capacity.

Sphere works to ensure humanitarian responses meet minimum standards in areas such as water, sanitation, shelter, health, nutrition and food security. It promotes dignity for people affected by crises, while guiding organisations to deliver principled, effective humanitarian assistance.

This programme is specifically designed for humanitarians in Gaza who are on the ground responding to the crisis and supporting communities in Gaza.
